## **Concession agreement**

- Exclusive use of certain amount of sqm
- Within a department store
- By a brand
- For the sale of certain defined products of that specific brand
- With its own staff
- Against a fee/sqm or a % of turnover



## = Lease agreement

- According to Dutch law a concession agreement ticks the boxes of lease of a business space
- Concession agreement is therefore qualified as a lease agreement
- Governed by (semi) mandatory law, Title 7.4 of the Dutch Civil Code



# Application to the Courts

- certain conditions, like alteration concession area, increasing concession fee and term of the agreement deviate from semi-mandatory Dutch lease law
- de Bijenkorf therefore only enters into concession agreements under the suspensory condition that a joint court application (with respect to these deviated conditions) is filed and approved by the competent sub district court pursuant to Article 7:291, paragraph 2 of the Dutch Civil Code

- location, number of doors (including online) and sqm of concession area
- term & termination
- product categories
- Fees
- events



# Brand should take responsibility for

- Staff
- Liability for damage to concession area
- Operating the area in an excellent manner
- Furnishing & maintenance of area
- Advertising
- Loss



# Discussion brand/department store

- Liability for damage concession area
- Loss
- Furnishing & maintenance
- Modification concession area
- Charges
- Collecting customer data
- Use of branded shopping bags
